Re: Request for approval of revised 2023 and 2024 Inspection and Maintenance Plans for Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company and West Penn Power Company

Dear Ms. Singh:

On April 28, 2023, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company and West Penn Power Company (collectively, FirstEnergy) filed its Joint 1st Quarter 2023 Reliability Report – Public Version (Reliability Report). Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 57.193(c) and § 57.195, in its Reliability Report FirstEnergy requested approval of a modification of its Inspection and Maintenance Plans (I&M Plans) for 2023 and 2024. FirstEnergy provided as an addendum to its Reliability Report clean and redlined versions of its modified I&M Plans. The revised I&M Plans for 2023 and 2024 proposed the addition of a distribution wood pole treatment program that would serve as a life extension mechanism for existing poles. FirstEnergy stated that the modified I&M Plans are otherwise consistent with its previously approved plans for 2023 and 2024 and proposes no substantive changes to its inspection cycles.

The revised I&M Plans for FirstEnergy that cover the years 2023 and 2024 are hereby approved. If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
