Re: Application for the Cancellation of Electric Generation Supplier License for
Community Energy, Inc.

Dear Mr. Stewart:

On September 13, 2022, Community Energy, Inc. (Community Energy) filed an application to abandon its Electric Generation Supplier (EGS) license as a supplier in Pennsylvania. Community Energy was issued an EGS license to operate as a broker/marketer on October 25, 2001, serving residential, small commercial (25 kw and under demand), large commercial (over 25 kw demand), industrial, and governmental customers in the entire Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. On September 13, 2012, Community Energy was approved to amend its license to operate as a *supplier* to residential, small commercial (25 kw and under demand), large commercial (over 25 kw demand), industrial, and governmental customers in the electric distribution company service territories of PECO Energy Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, Duquesne Light Company, and West Penn Power Company within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

There are no outstanding fines pending against Community Energy. There are also no outstanding formal or informal complaints and Community Energy does not serve any customers.

Based on the foregoing, the notification provisions under 52 PA Code Section 54.41(b) are waived, as are the notification provisions in the Interim Guidelines Regarding Notification by an EGS of Operational Changes Affecting Customer Service and Contracts, at Docket No. M-00960890F0013.


We believe that the relinquishment and abandonment of Community Energy's license will have no impact on the public, EDCs, or default service providers. Therefore, the Commission approves, by this Secretarial Letter, Community Energy's application to abandon its EGS License at Docket No. A-110152 and its license is cancelled.

The Secretary's Bureau shall remove the company's name from all active utility lists maintained by the Commission. The Bureau of Administrative Services shall remove the

company from all assessment lists. Additionally, if there are no outstanding claims against Community Energy's financial security sixty (60) days after the service date of this letter, the Secretary's Bureau shall return Community Energy's financial security instrument.
