
3. On February 22, 2022, the Department filed an Application with the Commission, seeking to alter the existing crossing where State Route 0921, locally known as Maple Street, crosses over the two tracks of Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“Norfolk Southern”) in Mount Wolf Borough, York County, by installing an additional mast and new roundels.
4. By Secretarial Letter dated August 15, 2022, the Commission approved the application and directed that Norfolk Southern, at the Department’s sole expense, complete “. . . all work necessary to alter the crossing. . . on or before August 31, 2023.”
5. Norfolk Southern has informed the Department that, due to adjustments to the project scope, design and agreements, as well as supply chain issues, additional time is required to complete the necessary alteration work.
6. Therefore, the Department respectfully requests an extension of time from the August 31, 2023 date contained in the Secretarial Letter dated August 15, 2022, as follows:

13. All work necessary to alter the crossing be completed in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before ~~August 31, 2023~~, *June 30, 2025*, and that on or before said date, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation report in writing to this Commission the date of actual completion of the work.

WHEREFORE, the Department of Transportation respectfully requests that the Public Utility Commission Secretarial Letter dated August 15, 2022, be modified consistent with this Petition.
