

A-20 PAWC-WD's response to Data Request A-12 indicated the requested service territory is not included in Franklin Township's Official Sewage Facilities Act 537 Plan (Act 537 Plan), but included a copy of the application the Baumgardner's submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for a sewage facilities planning module. An application to DEP for a sewer planning module does not provide evidence that the requested service territory complies with Franklin Township's DEP approved Act 537 Plan. Please provide a copy of the completed sewage facilities planning module submitted to DEP for the requested service territory along with evidence of DEP's approval of the same.
