On June 30, 2023, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) accepted Sunstar C&E Services, LLC's application for an Electric Generation Supplier license. In order for us to complete our analysis of your application, the Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached questions.



Data Request

1. Reference Application - The applicant stated throughout its EGS Application Package that the name of the applicant is “Sunstar C&E Services LLC”. Applicant stated its name on its bond as “SUNSTAR C&E SERVICES LLC”. According to the applicant’s PA Department of State registered name, the name must be written as “Sunstar C&E Services, LLC” (notice the capitalization and punctuation differences). To correct the naming in the application, the applicant may provide a statement attesting that Sunstar C&E Services LLC is the same as Sunstar C&E Services, LLC. Applicant must provide a bond with its name as per registration with the PA Department of State.
2. Reference Application, Section 7.a, Financial Fitness – Applicant failed to provide a Commission approved financial security. Applicant’s bond does not match the template provided in the EGS Application Package. The third paragraph starting with “NOW THEREFORE” has the fourth line missing, which should state the following: “*and regulation of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission by the Principal as a licensed electric...*”. Please provide a corrected bond that reflects the language found in the EGS application templates. Please note, the Commission **highly recommends** applicants use the Continuous Bond Template that can be found in Appendix E of the EGS Application.
3. Reference Application, Section 7.b, Financial Fitness – Applicant provided a bank statement that is not legible. Please provide three recent consecutive months of legible bank statements.
