Electric Generation Supplier License Cancellations of  
Companies with an Expired Financial Security

**FINAL ORDER**

On April 20, 2023, a Tentative Order was entered in the above captioned proceeding.


The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.42(a) require that a licensee shall comply with the applicable requirements of the code and Commission regulations and orders. Consistent with due process, a license may be suspended or revoked, and fines may be imposed against the licensee for failure to furnish and maintain a bond or other security approved by the Commission in the amount directed by the Commission.

On June 26, 2023, a Final Order was entered in the above captioned proceeding. The Final Order stated, among others, that a decision regarding Integrity Communications of Ohio LLC's EGS license, at Docket No. A-2010-2175245, was pended until a final resolution of an ongoing formal complaint<sup>1</sup> or if Integrity Communications of Ohio LLC furnishes an approved financial security.

On July 24, 2023, Integrity Communications of Ohio LLC filed an approved financial security and is currently in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §54.42(a).

The Tentative Order has become FINAL by operation of law.
