INITIAL TELEPHONIC HEARING DATE**


PECO Energy Company (“PECO” or the “Company”), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b), hereby respectfully requests a continuance of the initial telephonic hearing date scheduled in this matter and, in support, states the following:

1. An initial telephonic hearing in this matter is scheduled currently for Tuesday, August 22, 2023 at 10:00 A.M.
2. PECO is requesting a continuance of the August 22, 2023 hearing date because settlement discussions between PECO and the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) are ongoing and the parties would like additional time to continue these discussions.
3. The hearing notice in this matter states, “[y]ou may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. All continuances will be granted only for good cause.”
4. PECO avers that “good cause” exists to continue the scheduled hearing to a later date to allow the parties additional time to contemplate and possibly complete a settlement.
5. PECO is authorized to represent that I&E supports this request for a continuance of the August 22, 2023 hearing date.

6. The parties respectfully request a sixty (60) day continuance, at which time the parties will provide Your Honor an update regarding the status of settlement discussions or request another hearing date.

7. PECO, with the consent of I&E, therefore respectfully requests a continuance of the August 22, 2023 hearing date.


