
Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:

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CHRISTENSON DRIVING SERVICE LLC
Data Request

1. Based upon the description of your proposed operations and vehicles it appears that you are actually proposing to provide one of three potential authority types: limousine (luxury vehicle service), paratransit (trips to doctors, work, shopping, etc), or airport transfer.

There can be some overlap with limousine and airport transfer authority, but that is determined by your mode of operation and vehicle registration. Paratransit cannot be offered in limousine registered vehicles, and vice versa. These are issues which you must sort and clarify prior to moving forward with your application. You are highly encouraged to consult with an experienced transportation attorney if you are unable to separate these services on your own. Please bear in mind that each authority requires its own application and fee. Additionally, this Commission has no jurisdiction over interstate operations so any language related to that should be removed from your proposed operations.

2. Upon determining your correct authority type, you will need to further clarify your proposed area of operations. The proposed service area must be fully bound, and easily discernible. This may be achieved by the use of municipal boundaries, roads, railroads, or natural boundaries such as rivers and streams, etc. Statements which indicate a territory, “centered” on certain counties is insufficiently vague.

YOU SHOULD ONLY SPECIFY AREAS FROM WHICH YOU WISH TO ORIGINATE SERVICE.

Example:

- a. between points in the counties of X, Y, and Z.
 - b. from points in the counties of X, Y, and Z, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.
3. As presently submitted, the response to question 5 of the verified statements does not indicate essential hiring and employment requisites. You are expected to provide a PLAN that satisfies the requirements of 52 Pa Code. You are hereby directed to fully review the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and to provide a summarization of your revised and compliant plan for drivers.
 - § 29.503. Age restrictions – (Minimum age not provided)
 - § 29.504. Driver history – (Schedule not provided)
 - § 29.505. Criminal history – (Schedule not provided)

4. You are required to provide an error free complete and **dated** balance sheet. The information must be comprised of information which is less than 6 months old and should consist of accurate information and not rounded numbers or estimates. The information provided is also to be strictly limited to assets and debts **HELD BY THE APPLICANT (CHRISTENSON DRIVING SERVICE LLC)**, and not the individual member. **Any property listed must be registered or titled to the corporation** – personal property should not be included. If assets need transferred to the applicant from the individual member(s) then this should be done prior to submitting this response so that the balance sheet is an accurate reflection of the applicant's financial position.
