

Status of PAR**

Dear Judge Dunderdale:

Pursuant to *Second Interim Order on Remand*, please accept this Status Report regarding the payments that Roberta Zenmon (Complainant) agreed to pay to Pennsylvania Power Company (Penn Power) at the scheduled Telephonic Hearing on January 19, 2023, which resolved the issue on remand directed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) for service in the Complainant's name to 131 Lewisham Road, Cranberry Township, Pennsylvania under Closed Account No. 110148871137 in the above-referenced proceeding.

As agreed, on January 20, 2022, Penn Power retrieved the debt, in the amount of \$1,070.85, from its outside collection agency. The parties agreed to a 6-month payment arrangement (PAR) whereby the Complainant agreed to pay \$178.48 by the 15th of the month, beginning February 15, 2023. The last payment, in the amount of \$178.48, posted on June 29, 2023.

The Company PAR has defaulted; the outstanding balance for the Closed Account is \$176.41. Since the matter was not resolved, a hearing should be scheduled.
