On March 31, 2023, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc., filed its Proposed 2024-2028 Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan (2024 USECP) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The filing was pursuant to Section 2203 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 2203 (relating to standards for restructuring of natural gas industry), and to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 62.4 (relating to universal service and energy conservation plans).

On July 11, 2023, the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) filed and served a Petition to Intervene in the proceeding. Intervention is pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.71 — 5.76 (relating to intervention). Answers to the Petition to Intervene were due within 20 days of service of the Petition to Intervene. *See* 52 Pa. Code § 5.66 (relating to answers to petitions to intervene). More than 20 days have passed. No objection has been filed.

Without objection from any party, the Petition to Intervene filed by CAUSE-PA on July 11, 2023, is granted.
