Dear Mr. Sniezek:

On June 28, 2023, the Public Utility Commission (Commission) received Renodis ER, LLC d/b/a Eric Ryan Company's application for a Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) license.

Sections 2.b, 7.a, 8.a, 8.e, and 11.b of the application were incomplete or not properly completed (ex. 2.b applicant is a foreign LLC, not a foreign corporation and 11.b is missing pg. 1). In addition, the applicant failed to submit complete notarized proofs of publication for the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette and the Scranton Times-Tribune. In order for the Commission to accept the application for review, these deficiencies must be corrected. Failure to respond timely will result in the application being deemed rejected¹ and the docket will be closed.

Please use the Commission's e filing system or an overnight delivery service to submit the requested information to the Secretary of the Commission **within 20 days** from the date of this letter. Please submit revised application pages for each section. The Commission accepts all public documents through our e filing system and strongly recommends companies open an e filing account through the Commission's website at <https://efiling.puc.pa.gov>. Use of the e filing system will ensure that submissions by the company are received timely and receipt can be verified.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to either file by overnight delivery or submit to the Secretary's Share Point File system to ensure the timely filing of your submission. 




