An application to DEP for a sewer planning module does not provide evidence that the requested service territory complies with Franklin Township's DEP approved Act 537 Plan. Please provide a copy of the completed sewage facilities planning module submitted to DEP for the requested service territory along with evidence of DEP's approval of the same.

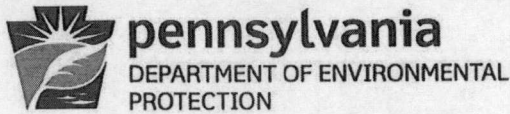

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has received the above referenced subdivision plan. This confirms DEP's determination that the above referenced project is exempt from the requirement to revise the Official Plan for new land development. This determination is based in part on municipal and other signoffs. The project consists of a four-lot single-family residential subdivision on 2.7548 acres with total estimated sewage flows of 900 gpd tributary to the PA American Water Company Franklin Township wastewater treatment plant. The proposed development is located at 3131 Chambersburg Road in Franklin Township, Adams County.

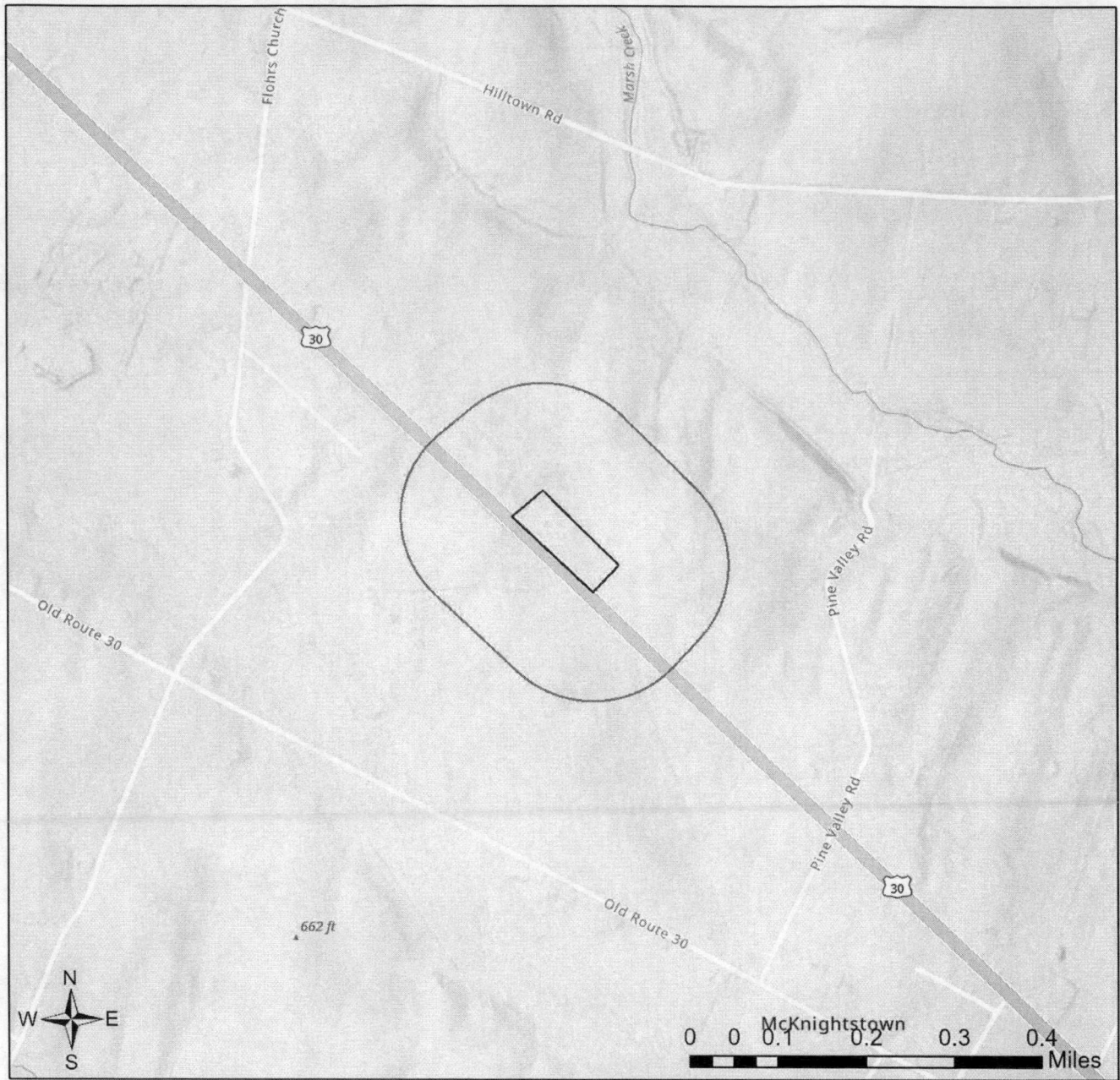

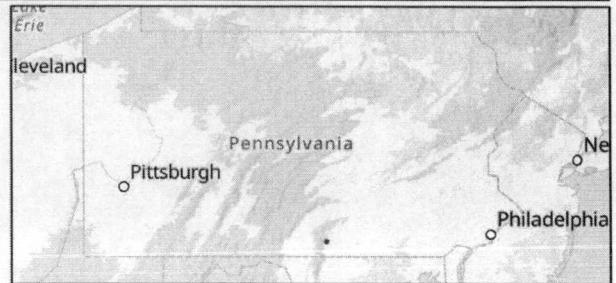
