On behalf of The O.E. Group Inc, enclosed, please find revised pages for the Application of The O.E. Group Inc. to become a licensed broker of electricity in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The O.E. Group Inc. provides electricity advisory services, including procurement support. The O.E. Group Inc. was a licensed electricity broker in Pennsylvania (licensed in Docket No. A-2018-2647476) until a February 2023 order in Docket No. M-2022-3030286, when its license was suspended for failure to provide the Commission with the required financial security. A copy of the Pennsylvania License is provided here as Exhibit 3. While operating under an active license, The O.E. Group Inc. assisted approximately seven (7) customers with electricity procurement services. These customers are still active customers of The O.E. Group Inc.

Through a series of one or more administrative errors, The O.E. Group Inc. failed to communicate with the Commission that it had renewed its required surety bond. The O.E. Group Inc. did in fact renew its surety bond. Attached as Exhibit 4 to this application is a receipt from Old Republic Surety Group dated August 31, 2022, showing a renewal of the surety bond for two years, with an effective date of November 22, 2022.

The Applicant is also operating as a fully licensed broker for natural gas services and have been operating as such since 2019. That license was approved in Docket No. No. A-2018-3000443. The PA gas license is presented as Exhibit 5.

The O.E. Group Inc had its electricity broker license revoked in Pennsylvania for failure to provide the Commission with an updated surety bond. This action was taken in Docket No. M-2022-3030286. A final order in that docket was issued on February 17, 2023. As shown elsewhere in this application, The O.E. Group Inc. did not ever let the bond lapse, however, it failed to deliver the updated surety to the Commission.

The O.E. Group Inc has not been subject to any regulatory actions in any other state.

As an initial remedy, The O.E. Group Inc is filing this Application and seeking forgiveness from the Commission for its compliance oversight. The O.E. Group, Inc. has committed to enhancing its internal compliance practices and has retained the services of Electric Advisors Consulting, LLC to assist in that process.

As noted above, it has seven (7) electricity customers in Pennsylvania.
