Application of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for approval to alter the public crossing (DOT 501 487 V) by the installation of an additional mast equipped with new automatically operated flashing-light crossing warning signals and the installation of new LED flashing-light roundels where State Route 0921 (Maple Street) crosses, at grade, two (2) tracks of Norfolk Southern Railway Company located in Mount Wolf Borough, York County all in accordance with the Federal Grade Crossing Program and the allocation of costs incident thereto.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated August 15, 2022, we directed the alteration of the crossing (DOT 501 487 V) where State Route 0921 (Maple Street) crosses, at grade, two (2) tracks of Norfolk Southern Railway Company, located in Mount Wolf Borough, York County. All work at the subject crossing was to be completed on or before August 31, 2023.

By petition filed on July 19, 2023, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation requests the Commission grant an extension of time in which to complete the work due to adjustments to the project scope, design and agreements, as well as supply chain issues.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant Pennsylvania Department of Transportation an extension of time to June 30, 2025.

This Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code.

THEREFORE:

The petition received by the Commission on July 19, 2023 from Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed:

1. Paragraph 13 of our Secretarial Letter dated August 15, 2022, which reads as follows, to wit:

“13. All work necessary to alter the crossing be completed in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before August 31, 2023, and that on or before said date, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation report in writing to this Commission the date of actual completion of the work.”

be and is hereby modified to read:

13. All work necessary to alter the crossing be completed in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before June 30, 2025, and that on or before said date, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation report in writing to this Commission the date of actual completion of the work.

2. In all respects not inconsistent herewith, our Secretarial Letter dated August 15, 2022, remain in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
