**Re: Application of Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. pursuant to Sections 1102, 1329, and 507 of the Public Utility Code for Approval of its Acquisition of the Water System Assets of Shenandoah Borough and MABS

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Opinion and Order entered on July 13, 2023 at the above docket, Ordering Paragraph 8, Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Aqua") filed Tariff Supplement No. 4 to Tariff Water-PA P.U.C. No 3, which establishes rates for the Shenandoah Division ("Settlement Tariff"). Aqua discovered an error on the gallonage blocks of the Monthly Consumption Charge: Rate per 1,000 gallons in the Settlement Tariff which had inadvertently included gallonage in the third block, which should have been in the fourth block and thereafter impacting the fifth block. As such the correct third block is now the "Next 1,000 Gallons", the corrected fourth block is now the "Next 4,000 Gallons", and the corrected fifth block is now "Greater than 7,000 Gallons". These corrections are represented in the enclosed corrected Compliance Tariff Supplement No. 4 to Tariff Water-PA P.U.C. No. 3. The rates for the Shenandoah Division customers are not changing through the correction to the gallonage blocks in this corrected Compliance Tariff filing.
