

Our secured file cabinets will house and maintain all required records by the PUC including drivers records background checks, drug test, and trainings etc. all records will be updated annually and maintained for the required time as well as our normal business records LifeAlert will receive customer request through our business phone line, and will communicate with our drivers via cell phone. Drivers will only be able to communicate when the vehicles are not in motion. If there is something urgent we will use a 2-way radio communication

Must have a good standing driving record, Must be able to pass a criminal background check Must be able to pass a drug test and at a minimum of three years experience driving. Criminal background checks will be done prior to hire and will be updated annually LifeAlert training program consist of comprehensive classroom training subjects includes Driving policies, and Procedures, Regulatory compliance, Vehicle Maintenance, and Inspections, Accident reporting procedures, and Defensive driving procedures. After successfully completing the classroom portion of the training New drivers then would be assigned a Driver trainer to ensure and evaluate the new drivers overall driving skills and techniques

LifeAlert will Request for all Drivers Information by filing a DL-503 form and submitting it to the Pennsylvania DOT to do driver's license checks.

LifeAlert prohibits the use of any drugs or alcohol we will do drug and alcohol test Pre Employment, Post Accident and Random, upon Reasonable Suspicion
