FINAL ORDER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 332(h) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §332(h), the decision of Administrative Law Judge Conrad A. Johnson dated July 14, 2023, has become final without further Commission action;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Complaint, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement v. Diamond Cargo Express LLC at Docket No. C-2023-3037641 is sustained.
2. That the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement's Motion for Default Judgment at Docket No. C-2023-3037641 is granted.
3. That Diamond Cargo Express LLC shall pay its \$14.00 Assessment Invoice for the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year, as required by 66 Pa. C.S. § 510(c).

4. That I&E's request for a \$550.00 penalty against Diamond Cargo Express LLC is granted pursuant 66 Pa.C.S.A. § 3301 et seq. and 52 Pa. Code § 69.1201.

5. That within thirty (30) days of the entry date of the Commission's Final Order, Diamond Cargo Express LLC shall remit \$564.00, payable by certified check or money order to "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania" with the docket number of this proceeding listed, and sent to:

6. That a copy of this Opinion and Order shall be served upon the Financial and Assessment Chief, Office of Administrative Services.

7. That the Bureau of Administrative Services, Assessment Section shall monitor this matter for compliance.

8. That Diamond Cargo Express LLC shall cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S.A §§ 101, et seq., and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.1, et seq.

9. That, if Diamond Cargo Express LLC fails to make the \$564.00 payment required by Ordering Paragraph No. 5 above, within thirty (30) days of the entry date of this Opinion and Order, it is further ordered:


a. That the Bureau of Technical Utility Services shall cancel the Certificate of Public Convenience held by Diamond Cargo Express LLC at Docket No. A-00121989 without further action by the Commission;

b. That the Commission will send a copy of this Order to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the suspension or revocation of vehicle registrations that were used under Diamond Cargo Express LLC's operating authority; and

c. That the Bureau of Administrative Services, Assessment Section, shall refer this matter to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General for collection of the total set forth above and appropriate action.

10. That, after Diamond Cargo Express LLC remits the payment of \$564.00 required by Ordering Paragraph No. 5 above, the Secretary's Bureau shall mark this proceeding closed.
