Mr. Kwiatkowski,

Thank you for your second data request in response to our application for PUC Limousine authority for CHRISTENSON DRIVING SERVICE LLC (Docket No. A-2023-3041922).

Below we have responded to each of your inquiries.

1. Attached is a completed sample tariff, demonstrating our intention to provide our proposed service within the guidelines of the Limousine authority. As a sample, this document has not been submitted to the Tariff Specialist.
2. You asked about the distinction between the statement in our original application that we may provide transportation to “[s]pecialist medical facilities such as UPMC, Hershey Medical Center, Johns Hopkins Medical Center, York Hospital” and our clarification that “[o]ur focus is not on driving people to local doctor appointments.” The primary difference is the distance, and therefore time, of the trip relative to the cost of service. Since we have a one-hour minimum charge and charge for a premium service, it would be unlikely that anyone would find our services desirable for a local appointment. Someone might reasonably find it worthwhile to engage our service for transportation to a distant appointment. All transportation would be paid fully by the client, not by Medicare or any other program.
3. Please also see attached a map of our proposed territory. This reflects visually our intention “to transport customers from points in Franklin County, Cumberland County, Fulton County east of US 522 (including all of McConnellsburg), Huntingdon County east of US 522 and south of PA 641 (including all of Shade Gap), and Adams County west of US 15 (including all of Gettysburg) to points in Pennsylvania and return.”

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Advance reservations are required and must be made 24 hours prior to service being rendered.
2. Full payment is required prior to service.
3. Hourly rates commence at the time the vehicle arrives at the first pick up point of the client and shall conclude at the last drop-off point of the client.
4. Additional expenses necessitated by or incurred at the request of the passengers, including but not limited to, highway tolls, bridge tolls, entrance fees and parking, shall be added to the charge of the trip. Expenses for driver's lodging and meals while on trips out of town which are in excess of ten (10) hours will be added to the basic charge.
5. Trips on the following Holidays are subject to an additional fees of \$120:
  - New Year's Eve and New Year's Day
  - Easter Day
  - Memorial Day
  - Independence Day
  - Labor Day
  - Thanksgiving Day and Black Friday (Day after Thanksgiving)
  - Christmas Eve and Christmas Day
6. A charge of \$60 will be assessed to a fare in which the pick-up occurs before 6:00AM or the drop off occurs after 10:00PM.
7. Waiting time will be subject to a charge of \$30 per 30 minutes.
8. An automatic gratuity of 20% shall be added to all charges.

## SCHEDULE OF RATES

Hourly Rates: – Minimum charged will be for 1 hours, or any fraction thereof. Additional time will be charged in thirty (30) minute / half hour increments, or any fraction thereof, at the following rates:

Standard Hours: 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM

One hour \$120.00

Additional 30 Minutes, or any fraction thereof: \$60.00

Evening Hours: 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM

Standard rates apply with an additional \$60.00 surcharge.

Weekend Hours: Saturday 12:01 AM to Monday 7:59 AM

Standard rates apply with an additional \$60.00 surcharge.

Holidays: 12:01 AM TO 11:59 PM

Standard rates apply with an additional \$120.00 surcharge.
