

All employees are on-site and trained and monitored by us. Sales people presentations and objection handlings that are practiced routinely. All phone calls are recorded and archived. There is a listen in function to hear live calls. There is a Sales Manager on the floor and an Operations Manager to oversee what is being said and done. Each of the main Closers have phone callers under them who they monitor. Our supplier contracts have agreements and some have codes on how to conduct ourselves when dealing with prospects and customers. We train our personnel on these procedures and enforce them. Our website and social media sites contain general information and invitations to contact us about our services. That covers all of our marketing. We have not had PUC complaints or lost any Supplier contracts for violations of the expected practices. Any subcontracted sales people put their deals/contracts through our employees or through the website which controls alterations of contracts or available rates.
