Dear Mr. Bauer:

On July 6, 1982, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission advised Amtrak that they have granted us until September 15, 1982 rather than December 1, 1982 to remove the Graham Avenue Bridge in Coatesville.

We are proceeding to comply with the Commission's order in this matter but before we proceed, a gas main located on the Bridge must be purged and cut free at each end.

We contacted Mr. Ed Silver who put us in touch with Mr. Dick Spealman of your gas division in Coatesville. Mr. Spealman has agreed to render the main inactive by August 31, 1982 after which date we will start work to remove the structure. We will call Mr. Spealman on August 31, 1982 to verify that the main is purged and cut free.

We wish to inform the Commission that on Tuesday, September 28, 1982, Amtrak removed the Graham Avenue Bridge from over our tracks in Coatesville, Pennsylvania. The work to remove the abutments, in accordance with paragraph 7 of the order dated July 6, 1982, will be done by our limited work forces as soon as scheduling permits.

Amtrak will submit to the Commission, the costs incurred to remove the structure and abutments exclusive of costs for permanent adjustments to our catenary system.

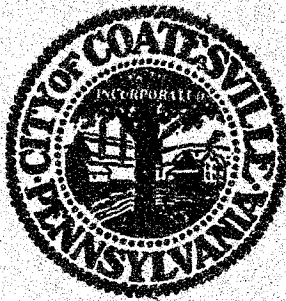

3. That Your Honorable Commission in Complaint Docket No. 00018838 issued its Orders dated February 5, 1982, modified by the Order of June 25, 1982, which directed, inter alia, National Railroad Passenger Corporation (AMTRAK), in Paragraph 7, to remove the superstructure and substructure of the bridge carrying State Highway Route 15122 over its tracks.

4. That AMTRAK removed the superstructure of the subject bridge on September 28, 1982, but has not, to date, removed the substructure.

5. That the City of Coatesville desires to have the superstructure replaced with funds appropriated by Act 235 of 1982. It is possible that the existing substructure, if altered to provide an adequate vertical clearance above the tracks, would permit a savings in the bridge replacement costs.


6. For the present, your Petitioner requests that the aforesaid Orders be modified to permit the existing substructure of the subject bridge to remain in place. When your Petitioner has developed further plans to replace the superstructure, a further Petition will be filed to make additional modifications to the said Orders.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner respectfully prays your Honorable Commission to modify Paragraph No. 7 of its Orders dated February 5, 1982, as amended by its Order of June 25, 1982, by deleting the words "and the substructure . . . etc." therefrom so as to read:

7. "That National Railroad Passenger Corporation, at its initial cost and expense, on or before September 15, 1982, furnish all material and perform all work necessary to remove the superstructure of the subject bridge, and submit monthly reports indicating its progress toward completion of this work."

AND, it will ever pray, etc.

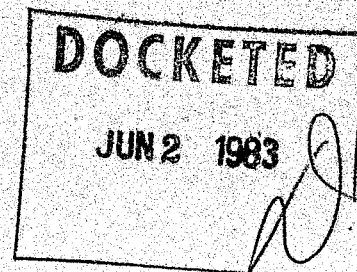
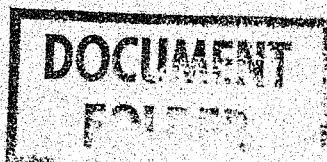
