## 7. FINANCIAL FITNESS

Applicant requests a reduction in the required \$250,000 bond level to the amount of \$10,000. In support of this request for a reduced bond level, Applicant notes that its services involve working with small and midsize commercial customers and helping those customers negotiate the purchase of electricity. Applicant does not take title to generation supply, nor does Applicant pay electricity bills on behalf of its customers.

#### **CRITICAL BONDING NOTES:**

Applicant is required to maintain a bond or other financial instrument the entire time it maintains an EGS license with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. If Applicant's security instrument is not continuous, Applicant **MUST** submit a Rider, Amendment, or Continuation Certificate annually based on the expiration date of its security instrument.
