However, if the services provided by Allied Acquisition Services LLC or the creditworthiness requirement for PECO's exposure to Allied Acquisition Services LLC changes in the future, PECO reserves the right to require Allied Acquisition Services LLC to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.

As you know, in making such an application, AAS must furnish acceptable security to each utility where AAS will do business. As such, under its tariff, NFGDC could require AAS to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that NFGDC determines to be appropriate.

However, you have indicated, and it is NFGDC's understanding that AAS intends only to provide natural gas aggregating, brokering and consulting services at this time. You have stated that, in performing these services, AAS will never take title to any delivered natural gas, nor will it accept any customer payments or deposits.

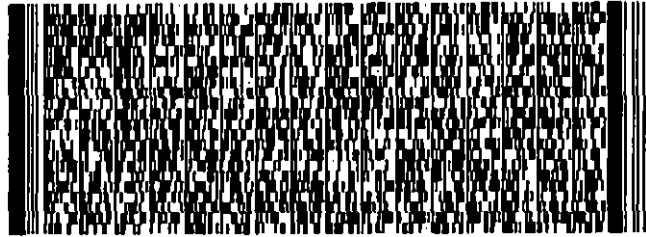

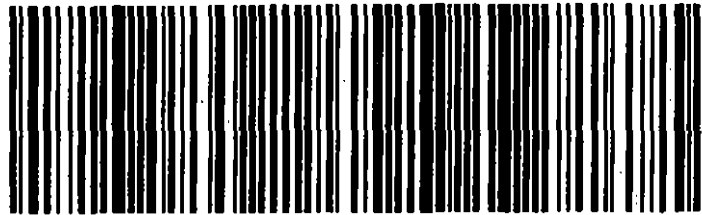
