Dear Attorney Lawrence:


The Commission received the Motion for Stay of the Application filed by the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) on September 25, 2023, regarding the above captioned and docketed matter.

Please know that the Commission has not yet accepted the Application of the Pennsylvania American Water Company (PA American) as it is still under review by the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §3.501. Therefore, any motions, protests, or other responsive pleadings made to this docket are at this time premature.

If the Application is accepted, the Commission would publish notice of the filing in the Pennsylvania Bulletin, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 3.501(d), with a protest period allowing the public to respond. Pursuant to this same Section, PA American is required to publish notice in local newspapers with circulation in areas affected by the filing.

Therefore, until the Application is finally accepted, the OCA's Motion for Stay of this Application cannot be considered at this time.
