It seems that Officer Gill has been misinformed. He also misled June Little. She said we traveled with folks, but did not say we were compensated for that. She thought he was asking about when I drove for Anna's Taxi when asking about rates. I did not leave Anna's Taxi to start any business, nor do I currently have any business. I left because they were making me pay for damages from when I hit a tree branch that had fallen on the road because she said they had filed two other claims and could not file another claim.

When Officer Gill spoke with me, I told him that I worked with a crew and we did travel together and was not being compensated for transporting. The Dailey's are familiar with this because she has, or did the last I knew, Aner working for a crew which he transports. She had me transporting that crew when he was stopped and found to be driving on an expired Mexican license on 3/12/20. Mr. Dailey also did the same thing (although he is on disability) for Stateline Concrete out of Jamestown, PA. He had his personal vehicle remarked to say it was leased. As I understand he was dismissed because he took a group on a trip out west and left them without transport.

Chris Hostetler, whom I work with, was briefly a client of Anna's Taxi that I did drive for a while in Anna's employe. Anna did give that job to other drivers and had me doing other runs. When she decided to raise the rates to more than he could pay, she told him to find another driver. He had other drivers, but found they could not do the email, computer work, and bookkeeping that I had done when I drove before. Thus, he asked me if I would be interested in that job. I am not being compensated for transporting. We just go to work together and I do my job there.

It would be interesting to know why her '05 Ford with PA registration JWJ 4396 which would not pass inspection was changed to Ohio registration while the crew was complaining that the fumes were making them sick. It seems that Mr. Dailey has a way of alienating employees and driving them away, even though they claim it is her business. They ran an actual business with multiple vehicles for several years without being registered with PUC. Yet now they have been filing complaints on people not doing anything wrong.


The complaint from Anna's Taxi is bogus. They will not get this crew back despite whatever spiteful maneuvers they try.
