Dear Mr. Lent:

By Order entered September 21, 2023, the Commission authorized UGI Utilities, Inc. Electric Division (the Company) to file a tariff supplement incorporating the terms of the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement of All Issues and changes to rates, rules and regulations as forth in Appendices A and B of the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement of All Issues filed in the above docketed rate investigation, as to permit an annual increase in base rate operating revenues of not more than \$8.5 million. On September 28, 2023, the Company filed Tariff Supplement No. 62 to UGI Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 and Tariff Supplement No. 9 to UGI Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2S to become effective October 1, 2023 in compliance with the Order.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the supplements are effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
