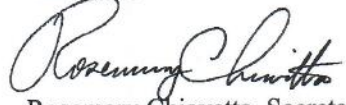
Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:

Data Request

1. In order for this Commission to accept an application for further processing, the proposed service area must be fully bound, and easily discernible. This may be achieved by the use of municipal boundaries, roads, railroads, or natural boundaries such as rivers and streams, etc. Generally speaking, naming counties is the most wide-spread manner of achieving this goal, but other properly bound descriptions are acceptable if properly prepared.

Based upon your stated resources you are not a candidate for statewide group and party (11-15) rights due to insufficient vehicles, drivers, and facility locations. Group and Party (11-15) service is not eligible for statewide rights by default (like limousine authority). **Limiting your proposed counties from 67 to 64 does not address your lack of resources.**

ONLY SELECT THE COUNTIES YOU WILL ORIGINATE SERVICE FROM. For example, it is highly unlikely that you will be originating trips in Erie County, but it is very probable that you will be originating trips in the several counties adjacent to your base of operations in Philadelphia County. If your operation grows in the numbers of locations, vehicles, and drivers, you can apply for further territory (if properly supported) at a later date.

YOU SHOULD ONLY SPECIFY AREAS FROM WHICH YOU WISH TO ORIGINATE SERVICE.

Example:

- a. between points in the counties of X, Y, and Z.
 - b. from points in the counties of X, Y, and Z, to points in Pennsylvania, and return, excluding areas under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority.
2. Question #5 of the applicant's verified statements requires that you describe your hiring and employment policies. You are expected to provide a PLAN that satisfies the requirements of 52 Pa Code. Please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and provide a revised compliant plan for drivers. Please provide a written description of your compliant hiring/driving policies with revision specific to:
 - **§ 29.503.** Age restrictions. (minimum age) – please explain the scenarios where you believe exceptions to the minimum age requirement (21) might be eligible/appropriate for your requested authority type.

- § 29.505. Criminal history. (schedule) – stating that you will follow the requirements of the cited code does not indicate that your policy is in fact compliant. Please plainly state the schedule you will be implementing to conduct criminal background checks. The statute is very specific.

The purpose of the verified statement questions is to determine your ability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable transportation. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses. Failure to do so is sufficient grounds to justify the denial of your application because YOU have failed to provide sufficient evidence of your fitness to operate. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings is highly encouraged.

29.503. Age restrictions. (minimum age) – please explain the scenarios where you believe exceptions to the minimum age requirement (21) might be eligible/appropriate for your requested authority type.

At our company we will only hire individuals who are of the age of 21 or older.

Pre-Employment Checks: Before hiring any new driver, we will conduct a comprehensive criminal background check as part of the pre-employment screening process. This background checks will continue to be checked every 2 years. This check will include a thorough search for convictions or pending charges related to the specific crimes listed in the statute. These specific crimes will be clearly outlined and include but are not limited to offenses such as:

- Violent crimes, including assault and robbery.
- Sexual offenses.

- Drug-related offenses.
- Crimes involving theft or dishonesty.

Regular Monitoring: We will regularly monitor the criminal records of our drivers to ensure ongoing compliance with 52 Pa Code. This monitoring will occur at least annually and will involve a review of the driver's criminal record to identify any new convictions or charges related to the listed crimes.

Immediate Reporting: If any driver is found to have a criminal conviction or pending charge related to the listed crimes, we will immediately report it to the appropriate authorities as required by law. In addition to reporting, we will take appropriate internal actions in accordance with our company policies and the law.
