

**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION**

---

**TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE BUCKLEY:**

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric”) hereby files this Motion for a Continuance pursuant to Section 5.103 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.103, and the September 15, 2023 Prehearing Order, and requests that the evidentiary hearing scheduled for October 19, 2023, in the above-captioned Complaint proceeding be continued.

In support of the instant Motion, PPL Electric avers as follows:

**I. REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE OF SCHEDULED EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

1. Pursuant to the September 15, 2023 Hearing Notice, there is a telephonic hearing scheduled in this matter for October 19, 2023 at 1:30 p.m.

2. Section 1.15(b) of the Commission’s regulations states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for

continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.

52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).

3. In addition, the Prehearing Order issued on September 15, 2023, provides the following:

You may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. Continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuance, you must submit a written request (a “motion”) at least five (5) days before the hearing. Your motion should include:

- (1) The case name, case number, and hearing date;
- (2) The reason you are requesting a continuance; and
- (3) State whether the other party(s) agrees to the request (or if you do not know).

Prehearing Order, p. 2 (September 15, 2023).

4. PPL Electric respectfully requests that the hearing be continued because the Company’s witness has a scheduling conflict on the hearing date, which makes the Company’s witness unavailable to participate in the hearing.

5. This is PPL Electric’s first request for a continuance in this matter.


6. On October 12, 2023, counsel for PPL Electric contacted the Complainant regarding this request for a continuance. As of the filing of this Motion, PPL Electric is unaware of whether the Complainant consents to the Company’s request for a continuance.

7. For these reasons, PPL Electric herein requests a continuance of the October 19, 2023 hearing.

**II. CONCLUSION**

WHEREFORE, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation respectfully requests that a continuance of the October 19, 2023 hearing be granted in the above-captioned proceeding.
