## SUPPLEMENT TO MOTION FOR STAY OF COMMISSION ORDER DATED APRIL 20, 2023

AND NOW, comes Respondent, Buffalo & Pittsburgh Railroad Company ("BPRR"), by its attorneys, Dickie, McCamey & Chilcote, P.C., J. Lawson Johnston, Esquire, Scott D. Clements, Esquire, and Aaron M. Ponzo, Esquire, and files its Motion for Stay of Commission Order Dated April 20, 2023, stating as follows:

- 1. BPRR filed its Motion for Stay of Commission Order Dated April 20, 2023, on July 11, 2023.
  - 2. I&E filed its Answer to the Motion on July 31, 2023.
- 3. No other party has filed an Answer or otherwise opposed the relief requested by BPRR, and the time to do so has passed.
- 4. BPRR filed its Petition for Review of the Commission's April 20, 2023 Order with the Commonwealth Court on May 18, 2023, at docket No. 489 CD 2023, and BPRR's brief was filed on August 21, 2023.
- 5. Under the current briefing schedule in the Commonwealth Court case, I&E's brief is due on October 23, 2023, and BPRR's reply brief due 14 days thereafter pursuant to Pa. R.A.P. 2185(a)(1).

6. BPRR sought a stay of the Commission's Order of April 20, 2023, because the

nine month time period prescribed by the Order will expire or be close to expired before the

Commonwealth Court has an opportunity to rule on the Petition for Review, and BPRR will

suffer irreparable harm if the Order is not stayed pending the Commonwealth Court's

decision.

7. BPRR provides this Supplement to its Motion in order to inform the

Commission of the briefing schedule in the Commonwealth Court case, which shows that the

nine month time period in the Commission's Order will almost certainly be expired before

the Commonwealth Court rules on the Petition for Review, which necessitates prompt action

on BPRR's Motion to Stay the Commission's Order of April 20, 2023.

WHEREFORE, Respondent Buffalo & Pittsburgh Railroad, Inc. respectfully requests

that the Commission grant its Motion for Stay of Commission Order Dated April 20, 2023.
