1. Paragraph 21. The language clearly implies PAWC provides water metered consumption to LRBSA. LRBSA uses this consumption to calculate the amount charged to residents. In addition, LRBSA applies this consumption to rates charged by PAWC for wastewater treatment. These rates were set by PAWC. This charge in turn being paid from LRBSA to PAWC plus service fee from LRBSA.

2. Paragraph 25. Please provide the rates that PAWC uses for all residential customers of LRBSA for all municipalities in Lackawanna County. For example, residents of Archbald Borough are billed \$60 for every three months by LRBSA. Why are LRBSA customers in different localities charged different rates? How can wastewater from one municipality cost more to handle/treat than that of a close neighbor?

3. Paragraphs 26 & 27. Rates should be the same across all localities served by LRBSA unless valid justification for different rates exists.

I am not an attorney. My response here comes from the perspective of a resident concerned about the very substantial increase in sewer rates effective January 1, 2023. I discussed sewer rates with residents of different municipalities in Lackawanna County who are also customers of LRBSA and their rates are inconsistent with our current rates. I would appreciate it if LRBSA and PAWC can explain the reason why such a significant increase and different in rates is being imposed all at once.
