Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Direct Energy Business, LLC ("Direct Energy") received authority to reduce its security with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission from 10% to 5% of Direct Energy's most recent twelve months of revenue, pursuant to a Secretarial Letter dated October 5, 2015. The Commission granted Direct Energy continuations of that 5% reduction in security requirements in 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022. Direct Energy files this Annual Compliance Filing to renew its security at the reduced level of 5% based on its most recent twelve months of revenue. This filing is being submitted at least 90 days prior to the anniversary date of Direct Energy's current financial security.
