FINAL ORDER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 332(h) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §332(h), the decision of Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge Mark A. Hoyer dated September 27, 2033, has become final without further Commission action;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Complaint of Geneva Perry in Geneva Perry v. Duquesne Light Company at Docket No. F-2022-3032577, is granted in part and denied in part.

2. That Complainant Geneva Perry’s request for a payment arrangement is granted.

3. That Complainant Geneva Perry shall pay monthly her current budget bill amount plus an amount equal to one-sixth (1/6th) of the arrearages accrued on her account beginning with the first billing due date following the entry of the Commission’s Final Order in this case.

4. That as long as Geneva Perry maintains the terms of the payment arrangement stated herein, Duquesne Light Company shall not suspend or terminate her utility


service except for valid safety or emergency reasons or assess late payments or finance charges against her account.

5. That if Geneva Perry does not keep the payment schedule stated herein, Duquesne Light Company is authorized to suspend or terminate her utility service in accordance with the Public Utility Code and Commission Regulations.

6. That Complainant Geneva Perry's claim that there are incorrect charges on her electric bill is denied.

7. That the Secretary's Bureau shall mark Docket No. F-2022-3032577 closed.
