SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 200 - PACKING CONTAINER CHARGES

(When furnished to shipper by carrier). Rates are in dollars and cents per each unit, except as noted. (Applicable on shipments transported under forty (40) miles).

NOTE A- When packing or unpacking service is requested by the customer or required by the carrier, charges will be calculated using the cost of containers shown above plus packing and unpacking labor using the hourly rates and applicable travel charge shown on Page 4 and Page 5 of this tariff.

NOTE B - In the event that two or more standard containers must be joined together because of the size, shape or character of the item or items to be packed, the charge for the container shall be the combined charge for all cartons use.

HOURLY RATES

Subject to Notes AA and 1 to 5 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3, and 4.

Hourly rates apply from the time of arrival to first point of origin (continued during all loading, transportation from first point of origin, as well as any extra stops, to final destination & unloading and dismissal of vehicle and men by shipper at destination.

The rates shown below apply to shipments traveling between points in Berks County and transported 40 miles or less.

NOTE 1 -Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) are based on the day or days, or period of days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour to be considered as one-half hour.

NOTE 4 - The additional cost for specialty items are as follows (these charges are in addition to the hourly rates):

Spinet/Console Piano - \$150.00 Upright/Baby Grand Piano - \$300.00 Carrier does not transport Grand Pianos

When flights are involved in the movement of pianos, add \$150.00 per flight.

Grandfather Clock - \$200.00 Bulky Items (250 pounds & over) - \$200.00 Exercise Equipment - \$200.00

NOTE 5 - When transporting a shipment on a Saturday, Sunday or Holiday for the convenience of the carrier, Monday-Friday rates will apply.

NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined mileage from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps or MapQuest.

0 - 15 miles	1/2 hour
16 - 30 miles	1 hour
31 - 50 miles	1 1/2 hours

For mileage in excess of 50 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 15 miles.
