Data Requests

1. Reference Application, Heading – The applicant stated its name in the application heading as “ClearPath Energy LLC d/b/a ClearPath Energy and utilized the name of ClearPath Energy throughout its application. Applicants must use the name **exactly** as registered with the Pennsylvania Department of State, “CLEARPATH ENERGY, LCC”, matching the capitalization, spacing, and punctuation. The d/b/a information also contradicts the information in Section 2.a of the application, where applicant stated that it will not be using a fictitious name. Due to these inaccuracies, please resubmit applicable pages with the applicant’s correct name or provide documentation (Form DSCB:54-311) from the Pennsylvania Department of State showing that the applicant has registered to utilize the fictitious name of ClearPath Energy.
2. Reference Application, Section 7.a, Financial Fitness – Applicant failed to provide a Commission approved financial security. Please provide a financial security with the original seal and wet signatures and updated with the applicant’s name **exactly** as registered with the Pennsylvania Department of State (including the comma.)
3. Reference Application, Section 7.b, Financial Fitness – Applicant provided two recent months of bank account statements. Please provide additional financial fitness documentation that may include a total of three recent months of bank account statements, or two recent consecutive years of income tax filings.
