METER READING AGREEMENT

This Meter Reading Agreement (“Agreement”), made this _____ day of _____, 2023 (the “Execution Date”), by and between Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc., a public utility corporation, duly organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with its principal place of business at 762 West Lancaster Avenue, Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania, 19010 (“Aqua”), and the Greenville Municipal Water Authority, a municipal authority duly organized and existing under the Municipal Authorities Act, with its principal place of business at 44 Clinton Street, Greenville, PA 16125 (“GWA”). Aqua and GWA shall each be referred to as a “Party” and collectively as the “Parties.”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Aqua is engaged in the business of providing wastewater service to the general public regulated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC” or the “Commission”) and bills certain customers rates based on water usage; and

WHEREAS, GWA is engaged in the business of providing water service to the general public in portions of Mercer County; and

WHEREAS, Aqua has entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement dated April 27, 2023, between Aqua and Greenville Sanitary Authority (“GSA”), for the purchase of the GSA’s wastewater treatment collection, and conveyance facilities (“GSA APA”); and

WHEREAS, GWA has available to it the records necessary to compute the water consumption by wastewater customers of Aqua who are also water customers of GWA; and

WHEREAS, GWA is willing to furnish Aqua certain information which will permit Aqua to compute and bill Aqua’s customers the charges for wastewater service under and subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth; and

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) paid by Aqua hereto to GWA, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and of the mutual covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto, each intending to be legally bound by the terms hereof, do covenant and agree as follows:

1. GWA agrees to furnish to Aqua the following information with respect to each of the customers in the Greenville Sanitary Authority:
 - (a) Customer name, customer number, and customer address;
 - (b) Consumption, and whether based on an actual or estimated meter read;
 - (c) Meter size and meter number;
 - (d) Current and past bill reading date; and

(e) Any other relevant billing information.

2. GWA further agrees to furnish (a) the information listed in Section 1 above, for all interim period bills such as final bills, new customer information and (b) information with respect to all adjustments which GWA may make in its water bills after it has furnished the information listed in Section 1 above.

3. Aqua agrees to pay for water consumption data at the rate of Two Thousand Three Hundred Eleven Dollars and Ninety-Four Cents (\$2,311.94) per month.

4. The information provided in Section 1 and Section 2, above, shall be provided in a mutually agreed upon format.

5. The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be the date upon which Aqua and the GSA close on the transaction contemplated by the GSA APA.

6. It is understood and agreed by the Parties hereto that the rate per month set forth in Section 3 shall remain in effect through the first year following the Effective Date of this Agreement. Following the first year if the transaction contemplated by the Asset Purchase Agreement dated September 26, 2023 between Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. and GWA for the purchase of GWA's water treatment and distribution facilities ("GWA Transaction") has not closed, the Parties shall negotiate this Agreement, including the per month rate and any provisions to be added for the termination of water service for nonpayment of wastewater service, until the GWA Transaction closes. This Agreement, subject to any change as described in this paragraph, shall renew on each anniversary of the Effective date following the initial one year period.

7. This Agreement shall terminate upon the mutual written consent of the Parties, or automatically without written consent of the Parties if Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. and GWA close on the GWA Transaction.

8. GWA shall bill Aqua promptly for the information furnished and Aqua agree to pay for such information within thirty (30) days after receipt of the GWA's invoice.
