4. The Complainant is authorized and directed by the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50, to represent the interests of small business consumers of utility services in matters before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”).

5. This Complaint is filed against the rates, terms, and other provisions of Supplement No. 45 to Tariff Water-PA P.U.C. No. 5 and Supplement No. 47 to Tariff Wastewater PA P.U.C. No. 16, which were filed with the Commission on November 8, 2023, by the Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“PAWC”). The rates set forth in the two Tariff Supplements, if approved by the Commission, would increase PAWC’s annual water and wastewater revenues by \$203.9 million.

6. After preliminary review of the materials filed by PAWC in support of the proposed Tariff Supplements, Complainant believes, and therefore avers, that those materials may be insufficient to justify the rate increase requested and that PAWC’s present and proposed rates, rules, and conditions of service may be unjust, unreasonable, unduly discriminatory, and otherwise contrary to law, particularly as they pertain to small business customers.

7. Complainant believes, and therefore avers, that PAWC’s proposed tariff changes and proposed rates, rate design, and revenue allocation are or may be unjust, unreasonable, and unlawfully discriminatory in violation of, *inter alia*, Sections 1301 and 1304 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1301 and 1304, and contrary to appropriate public policy and sound ratemaking considerations, and may not be supported by the materials filed by PAWC.

8. In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission:

- A. Suspend and investigate the operation of Supplement No. 45 to Tariff Water-PA P.U.C. No. 5 and Supplement No. 47 to Tariff Wastewater PA P.U.C. No. 16;
- B. At the conclusion of such investigation, reject the proposed new rates and other tariff changes proposed in the two Tariff Supplements to the extent required to make certain that PAWC's rates are lawful, just, reasonable, and not unduly discriminatory to small business customers; and
- C. Grant such other relief as may be necessary or appropriate.

**PUBLIC STATEMENT OF
THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interest of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (“Act”). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by her initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a complaint against the proposed base rate tariff filings of the Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“PAWC” or the “Company), which would increase the Company’s water and wastewater annual revenues in the amount of \$203.9 million.

The Small Business Advocate files this formal complaint against the Company’s proposed base rate tariff filings in order to protect the interests of the Company’s small business customers. A thorough inquiry by the Commission into all of the elements of the PAWC’s proposed base rate tariff filings is necessary to ensure that the tariff filings are lawful, just, reasonable, and not discriminatory to the Company’s small business customers.


In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings before the Public Utility Commission to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed base rate tariff filings. The Small Business Advocate will ask the Commission to deny any proposed new rates and other tariff changes that apply to small business customers that are not proven by PAWC to be lawful, just, reasonable, and not discriminatory to the Company's small business customers.
