**PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS’
MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE AND PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.15 and 5.103, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW” or “Respondent”) hereby files this Motion to convert the evidentiary hearing scheduled for November 29, 2023 into a prehearing conference pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.222 to simplify issues before fixing a new date for an evidentiary hearing in this matter. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated September 26, 2023, the Commission scheduled a telephonic hearing in this matter for Wednesday, November 29, 2023 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Arlene D. Ashton.
2. During the pendency of this matter, the gas service has been restored to the property, the disputed balance has been removed from Ms. Metuiwe’s account, and Ms. Metuiwe is no longer the customer of record at the Service Address.
3. The new customer of record at the Service Address, who Ms. Metuiwe has stated is her husband, has accepted the balance from Ms. Metuiwe’s account and is currently on a payment agreement.
4. PGW has spoken with Ms. Metuiwe via telephone to discuss the issues raised in this Motion.
5. Ms. Metuiwe has stated that she has no objection to PGW’s Motion and agrees that the hearing scheduled for November 29, 2023 should be converted to a prehearing conference.
6. Ms. Metuiwe has stated that the new account holder will be available to participate in the prehearing conference to help clarify issues.

WHEREFORE, PGW requests that the Commission grant PGW's Motion and convert the hearing scheduled for Wednesday, November 29, 2023 in this matter into a prehearing conference and schedule the evidentiary hearing in this matter to a later date.
