
On December 8, 2023, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a letter at the above captioned Application docket concerning an “Exhibit Z” which is referenced in paragraph 68 of the original application filed by Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. (Aqua) on November 17, 2023. OCA states in its letter that Aqua has designated Exhibit Z as Confidential Security Information (CSI).

However, on review of the filings in the Application docket, no “Exhibit Z” has been filed. In lieu of an actual Exhibit Z, Aqua filed a one-page tab titled “Exhibit Z Aqua Statement No. 4, Direct Testimony of John Childers (Confidential Security Information).” Moreover, the record reflects that Aqua filed two (2) exhibits both labeled as “Exhibit Y.” One “Exhibit Y” contains the Testimony of William Packer. This exhibit is NOT labeled as CSI. However, a second filing labeled as “Exhibit Y” was filed by hand with a transmittal letter on November 17, 2023, and contains the Direct Testimony of John Childers which Aqua has designated and labeled as CSI.

Additionally, the transmittal letter filed with the Direct Testimony of John Childers should be placed on the record in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Section 102.3(b)(1). This regulation requires that when submitting a record with the Commission that contains CSI, the filing party must state in the transmittal or cover letter why the information being submitted should be treated as CSI. The regulations also state that transmittal letters will be treated as a public record and may not contain any CSI. Upon further examination, the transmittal letter submitted with the Direct Testimony of John Childers does not meet the requirements of Section 102.3(b)(1).

Therefore, Aqua is hereby directed to (1) correct the existing mislabeling problem of the Direct Testimony of John Childers, and 2) re-file the transmittal letter in accordance with the Commission’s regulations. This Secretarial Letter and Aqua’s November 17, 2023, transmittal letter will be placed on the record of the docket.
