**E7 Power LLC will enter into contracts with electricity suppliers to offer these suppliers' plans. Through E7 Power LLC's websites customers will be able to learn about and enroll in available electricity plans in their area of interest.**

**As a broker, E7 Power LLC will merely connect potential customers with electricity suppliers. When a customer enrolls in an electricity provider's plan, E7 Power LLC will receive a commission from that supplier. Customers will arrange payment for their electricity directly with the electricity suppliers and under no circumstances will E7 Power LLC take title to the electricity or pay electricity bills on behalf of its customers.**

**CRITICAL BONDING NOTES:**

Applicant is required to maintain a bond or other financial instrument the entire time it maintains an EGS license with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. If Applicant's security instrument is not continuous, Applicant **MUST** submit a Rider, Amendment, or Continuation Certificate annually based on the expiration date of its security instrument.
