MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE¹

AND NOW comes the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”), Complainant in the above-captioned matter, by its prosecuting attorney, and files this Motion for Continuance of the litigation schedule, in accordance with Section 1.15(b) of the Commission’s regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b). In support thereof, I&E states as follows:

1. On June 5, 2023, I&E filed a Formal Complaint against PECO Energy Company (“PECO” or “Respondent”), for electric safety violations regarding an incident that took place on June 4, 2020 at the 15000 block of Beverly Drive, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
2. On June 26, 2023, PECO filed an Answer to I&E’s Complaint.
3. By Hearing Cancellation Notice dated October 4, 2023, Administrative Law Judge Marta Guhl (“ALJ”) granted the Motion for Continuance filed by PECO and

cancelled the telephonic hearing in the above-captioned matter scheduled for October 10, 2023.

4. Due to the departure of the assigned I&E Prosecutor in this matter, the undersigned filed an Entry of Appearance on December 11, 2023.

5. The undersigned is working diligently to become familiar with this file.

6. Moreover, the Parties to this matter continue to work toward an amicable resolution of this matter which may result in a settlement without the need for a hearing.

7. I&E is authorized to indicate that Respondent concurs in this request for a continuance of the litigation schedule.

8. The Parties respectfully request another sixty (60) day continuance, at which time the Parties will provide Your Honor an update regarding the status of settlement discussions or request another hearing date.

9. I&E and PECO agree to provide a Joint Status Report to the Presiding Officer within sixty (60) days of the date of the Order granting this Motion for Continuance to advise the Presiding Officer of the status of settlement discussion if no Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement has yet been filed.

10. Accordingly, I&E respectfully requests a further continuance of the litigation schedule for the above-captioned matter due to the recent entry of appearance of I&E counsel and the Parties' continued efforts to reach an amicable resolution of this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, I&E respectfully requests that the litigation schedule in the above-captioned matter be further continued and the Parties be directed to provide a status report to the Presiding Officer within sixty (60) days of the date of the Order granting this Motion for Continuance.
