ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 8, 2023, Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC), Utility Code 212285, filed Supplement No. 45 to Tariff Water-PA P.U.C. No. 5 (Supplement No. 45) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) to become effective January 7, 2024. Supplement No. 45 would increase PAWC's total annual operating revenues for water service by approximately \$199.2 million, or 24.2%.

On November 17, 2023, the Office of Consumer Advocate filed a formal complaint at Docket No. C-2023-3044289. On November 20, 2023, the Office of Small Business Advocate filed a formal complaint at Docket No. C-2023-3044375. Pursuant to Section 1308(d) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 1308(d) (relating to general rate increases), the filing will be suspended by operation of law until August 7, 2024, unless permitted by Commission Order to become effective at an earlier date.

Investigation and analysis of this proposed tariff supplement and the supporting data indicates that the proposed changes in rates, rules, and regulations may be unlawful, unjust, unreasonable, and contrary to public interest. It also appears that consideration should be given to the reasonableness of PAWC's existing rates, rules, and regulations; **THEREFORE**,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That an investigation on Commission motion be, and hereby is, instituted to determine the lawfulness, justness, and reasonableness of the rates, rules, and regulations contained in Pennsylvania-American Water Company's proposed Supplement No. 45 to Tariff Water-PA P.U.C. No. 5.
- 2. That Pennsylvania-American Water Company's proposed Supplement No. 45 to Tariff Water-PA P.U.C. No. 5 is suspended by operation of law until August 7, 2024, unless otherwise directed by Order of the Commission.
- 3. That within ten (10) days following the entry date of this Order, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 53.71, Pennsylvania-American Water Company shall e-file (or file) a tariff supplement, which shall bear no effective date, with the Commission and post the tariff supplement at the offices of Pennsylvania-American Water Company announcing that the aforementioned tariff supplement is suspended until August 7, 2024. A sample copy of a suspension supplement is provided in Attachment A of this Order.
- 4. That the investigation instituted in Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of this Order shall include consideration of the lawfulness, justness, and reasonableness of the existing rates, rules, and regulations of Pennsylvania-American Water Company.
- 5. That this case be assigned to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for Alternative Dispute Resolution, if possible, and for the prompt scheduling of such hearings as may be necessary culminating in the issuance of a recommended decision.

6. That a copy of this Order shall be served upon Pennsylvania-American Water Company, the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, and any persons who have filed formal complaints against the proposed tariff supplement.
