Dear Ms. O'Dell:

On December 22, 2023, Philadelphia Gas Works filed Supplement No. 169 to Gas Service Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 and Supplement No. 112 to Supplier Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1. These are housekeeping supplements which cancel and update certain tariff pages containing changes from overlapping supplement filings approved to be effective December 1, 2023. The approved tariff changes were filed in Supplement Nos. 167 and 168 (Gas Service Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2), and Supplement Nos. 110 and 111 (Supplier Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1). The proposed housekeeping supplements make no changes to Commission approved rates and regulations, and simply update certain pages to reflect all Commission approved changes effective December 1, 2023 from the overlapping supplement filings.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 169 to Gas Service Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 and Supplement No. 112 to Supplier Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 are effective by operation of law as of the effective dates contained on each page. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
