Re: PECO Energy Company – Request to Withdraw proposed Supplement No. 36 to Tariff Electric - Pa. P.U.C. No. 7

Dear Mr. Webster:

On October 20, 2023, PECO Energy Company (PECO or the Company) filed Supplement No. 36 to Tariff Electric - Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 (Supplement No. 36) to become effective January 16, 2024, which proposed revisions to the Company's tariff regarding implementation of a new customer information system - Customer Care & Billing (CC&B). The Company based the proposed effective date of Supplement No. 36 on the projected implementation in January of 2024. After the October tariff filing, the projected implementation timeline for CC&B was delayed but is still expected in the first quarter of 2024.

Based upon discussions with Commission staff regarding the uncertainty of the effective date of implementation, on December 1, 2023 the Company filed a request that Supplement No. 36 be withdrawn and replaced in its entirety with a concurrently filed pro forma version of the tariff supplement. The pro forma version removes supplement numbers and dates but makes no revisions to the proposed tariff changes in the original filing.

Please be advised that the Company's request has been approved, and the withdrawal of Supplement No. 36 to Tariff Electric - Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 is complete.
