On November 9, 2023, the Commission entered a Joint Motion at the above-captioned docket directing its Law Bureau and Bureau of Technical Utility Services to, by February 28, 2024, prepare for the Commission's consideration an Advanced Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANOPR) regarding any amendments or additions needed to align existing Commission regulations or policy statements with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC) Order No. 2222.

In an effort to obtain initial input from distributed energy resource (DER) aggregators, which may be impacted by the ANOPR, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) will be hosting a virtual meeting via TEAMS on February 1, 2024 from 2:00 pm – 3:00 pm EST.
