PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS' MOTION TO CONTINUE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) hereby files this Motion to Continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Tuesday January 16, 2024. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated November 15, 2023, the Commission scheduled a telephonic hearing in this matter for Tuesday January 16, 2024 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero.
2. In her Complaint, Jacinth Roberts (Complainant”) indicated that she is requesting a payment agreement.
3. In speaking with the Complainant, it has become clear that she is also disputing the accuracy of her bills.
4. It has also become clear that this Complaint references multiple units within the same property that the Complainant would like investigated.
5. PGW is still in the process of investigating the issues raised by the Complainant.
6. PGW’s investigation involves scheduling visits to the property to check the units and the testing of PGW equipment.
7. PGW will not be able to conclude its investigation prior to the scheduled hearing date.
8. PGW has spoken with the Complainant via telephone to discuss PGW’s request for a continuance in this matter; the Complainant has stated that she has no objection to PGW’s request and agrees that the matter should be continued so that PGW may conclude its investigation.

WHEREFORE, PGW requests that the hearing scheduled for Tuesday January 16, 2024, in the above captioned matter be continued.
