Dear Ms. Singh:

Pursuant to Commission Secretarial Letters dated December 28, 2023 (Dec Sec Letters), in the above-docketed matter, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, and West Penn Power Company (collectively, FE PA) were each directed to file a revised Biennial Inspection, Maintenance, Repair and Replacement Plan (Plan) within 30 days of the Dec Sec Letters.

On January 9, 2024, FE PA filed a request seeking a 30-day extension to comply with the directive of the Dec Sec Letters. FE PA notes that compliance with the 30-day directive would require significant logistical, budgetary and managerial changes that will take FE PA significant time to navigate and implement and that an additional 30 days would provide the necessary time for adequate compliance. FE PA states that the extension would require compliance on or before February 28, 2024. The Commission has reviewed FE PA's request for a 30-day extension for compliance and hereby approves the request.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days after the date of this letter.
