Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

By way of this letter, and pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 2 of the Order entered June 16, 2022 in the above-referenced matter, the Company hereby notifies the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") that the transmission line work outlined within the above-referenced Letter of Notification ("LON") to replace or relocate certain transmission structures on the Z-71 and Z-88 138kV circuits ("Project") has been completed and placed into service. The Project was placed into service on December 22, 2023.

The Company's LON estimated a total Project cost between \$6.4 million to \$12 million. As of December 31, 2023, total project spend was \$9,630,612. Additional costs will be incurred for the restoration work, which is expected to be completed in or around March 2024.

A copy of this letter has been served upon the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Technical Utility Services Representative assigned to this proceeding. Please contact me with any questions, comments, or concerns.
