We adopt as our action the Recommended Decision of Administrative Law
Judge Darlene Heep dated November 29, 2023;


THEREFORE,

IT IS RECOMMENDED:

1. That the Amended Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement filed November 1, 2023, be approved in its entirety.
2. That the Commission issue a Certificate of Public Convenience to Towamencin Township pursuant to Section 1101 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 1101, authorizing Towamencin Township, Inc., *nunc pro tunc*, to begin to offer, render, furnish, and supply wastewater service to the public in a portion of Worcester Township, Lower Salford Township as well as bulk customers that interconnect to the Township's sewer system outside of the Township's geographic boundaries consistent with the revised map and written description of the requested service territory provided in the Amended Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement and admitted Stipulated Exhibits.
3. That Towamencin Township be directed to file a Tariff supplement in its name with the Secretary's Bureau in this docket, effective on one day's notice, which adopts the terms, conditions and rates as indicated in Revised Exhibit T-6 of the Amended Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement.
4. That nothing in the Commission's Order shall be construed as an approval or determination of costs or expenses for the purposes of just or reasonable rates or to exempt Towamencin Township from obtaining all necessary permits, licenses, and approvals from other federal, state, and local government agencies having jurisdiction.

5. That upon issuance of a Final Order of the Commission, this matter be marked closed.
