CUSTOMER DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

This is an agreement for Electric Generation Service between Renaissance Power & Gas, Inc. (“Renaissance Power & Gas,” “We” or “Us”) and _____ (“Customer” or “You”).

Background

We at Renaissance Power & Gas are licensed by the Public Utility Commission to offer electric generation supply services in Pennsylvania.

Our PA PUC license number is **A-XXXX-XXXXXXX**.

We set the generation prices and charges that you pay. The Public Utility Commission regulates distribution prices and services. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates transmission prices and services.

You will receive a Single Bill from PPL that will contain PPL charges and Renaissance Power & Gas charges.

Right of Rescission - You may cancel this Agreement at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving this disclosure. Call 1-888-811-0877, or Customer may write at 5795 S. See Section 12 for how to contact us.

Definitions

Generation Charge- The charge for producing electricity. Generation service is competitively priced and is not regulated by the Public Utility Commission. If you purchase electricity from an electric supplier, your generation charge will depend on the contract between you and your supplier.

Transmission Charge The cost for transporting electricity from the generation source to your electric distribution company. For most electric Customers who select a new supplier, transmission costs will be included in the charges from your new supplier. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates retail transmission prices and services. This charge will vary with your source of supply.

Non-Basic Charges- Renaissance Power & Gas has no Non-Basic Charges.

TERMS OF SERVICE

1. **Basic Service Prices** - You will pay a fixed price of \$xxx per kWh for electric service. This price includes Transmission Charges (if applicable) and estimated Total State Taxes, including the Gross Receipts Tax, but excludes applicable state and local Sales Tax.
2. **Duration of Agreement.** For Fixed Rate service, you will buy your electricity service for the above address from Renaissance Power & Gas beginning on the date set by PPL. This Agreement shall commence as of the date Customer's notice regarding the change of Customer's provider to Renaissance Power & Gas is deemed effective by PPL and shall continue for 12 months thereafter (the "Initial Term").
3. **Special Terms and Conditions.** Renaissance Power & Gas does not offer any incentives, sign-up bonuses, limited time offers, or other sales promotions.
4. **Special Services** – Renaissance Power & Gas does not offer Special Services.
5. **Penalties, Fees, and Exceptions-** There is no early termination fee. The early termination fee shall be \$0.00.
6. **Billing.** You will receive a Single Bill from PPL that will contain PPL charges and Renaissance Power & Gas charges.
7. **Cancellation Provisions.** This category may consist of both Customer-initiated cancellation provisions and supplier-initiated cancellation provisions.
 - **Company-Initiated Cancellation** – If we cancel this Agreement for any reason other than for Customer non-payment, we will follow applicable rules in providing notice to you. See Section 8 for an explanation of the notices you will receive prior to cancellation.
 - **Customer-Initiated Cancellation** – If you cancel this Agreement before the end of the initial term, you will owe us for amounts unpaid up to the date of cancellation and return to the utility.
 - **Customer Move** – If the Customer moves from the address listed above to another utility service territory, this Agreement is canceled.
8. **Renewal /Agreement Expiration/Change in Terms.** If you have a fixed-duration Agreement that will be ending, or if Renaissance Power & Gas will seek to modify the Agreement, you will receive two separate notices before the Agreement ends or the changes happen. You will receive the first notice 45-60 days before the expiration date or the date the change becomes effective ("Initial Notice"), and the second notice 30 days before the expiration date or the date the change becomes effective ("Options Notice"). These notices will explain your options. Customer will not be subject to a penalty or fee if the Customer terminates this Agreement at any time between the date the Options Notice is issued and the expiration of this Agreement.
9. **Contract Assignment.** Customer may not assign its interests in and delegate its obligations under this Agreement without the express written consent of Renaissance Power & Gas. Renaissance Power & Gas. may sell, transfer, pledge, or assign the accounts, revenues, or proceeds hereof, in connection with any financing arrangement or receivables purchase program and may assign this Agreement to another energy supplier or other entity authorized by the PA PUC. If the Agreement is assigned, Renaissance Power & Gas will inform Customer of this and explain that prior to any assignment of the Agreement, Renaissance Power & Gas will provide 90 days written notice to you with the name of the new electric generation supplier ("EGS"), the contact information for the new EGS, the estimated month and year that the assignment is expected to occur, and language informing the Customer that the Agreement terms and conditions will remain unchanged.
10. **Consent to Obtain Customer Information.** Customer authorizes Renaissance Power & Gas. to obtain and review information from PPL such as the Customer's consumption history, billing determinants, account number; address; and telephone number. This information may be used by Renaissance Power & Gas. to determine whether it will commence and/or continue to provide energy supply service to the Customer and will not be disclosed to a third party unless required by law. Customer's execution of this Agreement constitutes authorization for the release of this information to Renaissance Power & Gas. This authorization will remain in effect during the Initial Term and any Renewal Term. The Customer may rescind this authorization at any time by providing written notice thereof to the address below or by calling Renaissance Power & Gas at 1-888-811-0877. Renaissance Power & Gas reserves the right to cancel this Agreement in the event Customer rescinds the authorization.

13. **Eligibility.** Net Metering- If you currently own or plan to install during the term of this Contract solar, wind, or other eligible renewable

electrical generating facilities in order to supply all or part of your electricity usage, and such generating facility is or will be net metered by the EDC you must notify us in order for us to determine your eligibility and to properly enroll or continue to serve you.

14. **Agency-Electric.** Customer hereby designates Renaissance Power & Gas as agent to; (a) arrange and administer contracts and service agreements between Customer and Renaissance Power & Gas and those entities including PJM Interconnection LLC ("PJM") engaged in the generation, transmission, and delivery of Customer electricity supply; and (b) schedule with the appropriate entities including the PPL for the delivery of electricity to the Sales Point and the Customer's end-use premises. Renaissance Power & Gas as agent for the Customer, will schedule the delivery of adequate supplies of electricity that meet the Customer's requirements as established by PPL and in response to information provided by PPL. The Sales Points for the electricity will be point at the PJM Renaissance Power & Gas load bus (located outside of the municipality where the Customer resides). These services are provided on an arm's length basis and market-based compensation is included in the price noted above.
15. **Title-Electric:** All electricity sold under this Agreement shall be delivered to the Sales Point, which constitutes the point at which title transfers and the sale occurs. Renaissance Power & Gas will indemnify and hold harmless Customer from all taxes, royalties, fees, or other charges incurred before title passes with respect to the electricity provided hereunder.
16. **Warranty.** This Agreement, including any enrollment form and applicable attachments, as written makes up the entire Agreement between Customer and Renaissance Power & Gas. Renaissance Power & Gas makes no representations or warranties other than those expressly set forth in this Agreement, and Renaissance Power & Gas expressly disclaims all other warranties, express or implied, including merchantability and fitness for a particular use.
17. **Force Majeure.** Renaissance Power & Gas will make commercially reasonable efforts to provide electricity hereunder but does not guarantee a continuous supply of electricity to Customer. Certain causes and events out of the control of Renaissance Power & Gas ("Force Majeure Events") may result in interruptions in service. In the event that Renaissance Power & Gas is rendered unable, wholly or in part, to perform its obligations under this Agreement due to events not reasonably anticipated or within either party's control, Renaissance Power & Gas will not be liable for any interruptions caused by a Force Majeure Event, and Renaissance Power & Gas is not and shall not be liable for damages caused by Force Majeure Events. Force Majeure Events shall include acts of God, fire, flood, storm, terrorism, war, civil disturbance, acts of any governmental authority, accidents, strikes, labor disputes or problems, required maintenance work, inability to access the local distribution utility system, curtailment by Customer's PPL or Renaissance Power & Gas Inc. transportation capacity, non-performance by PPL (including, but not limited to, a facility outage on its electric facilities), or any other cause beyond Renaissance Power & Gas Inc.'s control.
18. **Liability.** The remedy in any claim or suit by Customer against Renaissance Power & Gas will be solely limited to direct actual damages (which will not exceed the amount of Customer's single largest monthly invoice amount in the immediately preceding 12 months). All other remedies at law or in equity are hereby waived. In no event will either Renaissance Power & Gas or Customer be liable for consequential, incidental, indirect, special or punitive damages. These limitations apply without regard to the cause of any liability or damages. There are no third-party beneficiaries to this Agreement.
19. **Choice of Laws.** Venue for any lawsuit brought to enforce any term or condition of this Agreement or to construe the terms hereof shall lie exclusively in the Commonwealth of PA. This Agreement shall be construed under and shall be governed by the laws of the PA without regard to the application of its conflicts of law principles.
20. **Taxes and Laws.** Except as otherwise provided in the Agreement or provided by law, all taxes of whatsoever kind, nature, and description due and payable with respect to service provided under this Agreement, other than taxes based on Renaissance Power & Gas, Inc.'s net income, shall be paid by Customer, and Customer agrees to indemnify Renaissance Power & Gas and hold Renaissance Power & Gas harmless from and against any and all such taxes.
21. **Parties Bound.** This Agreement is binding upon the parties hereto and their respective successors and legal assigns.
22. **Forward Contract:** Each Party acknowledges that: (a) this Agreement is a forward contract and a master netting agreement as defined in the United States Bankruptcy Code ("Code"); (b) this Agreement shall not be construed as creating an association, trust, partnership, or joint venture in any way between the Parties, nor as creating any relationship between the Parties other than that of independent contractors for the sale and purchase of Commodities; (c) Renaissance Power & Gas is not a "Utility" as defined in the Code; (d) Commodity supply will be provided by Seller under this Agreement, but delivery will be provided by the Utility; and (e) the Utility, and not Renaissance Power & Gas, is responsible for responding to service problems or emergencies should they occur.
23. **Telephonic Communication:** By accepting this Agreement, you consent to receive calls and/or texts for any purpose, including with marketing offers and other information, from Renaissance Power & Gas, its affiliates, and/or assigns, at the telephone number(s) you provide to Renaissance Power & Gas, its affiliates and/or assigns, possibly through use of automated technology or pre-recorded voice. You agree that this consent survives the cancellation of your Agreement and that your consent to receive marketing communications is not a condition of purchase and may be revoked at any time.
24. **Environmental Characteristics and Renewable Electricity Characteristics.** If you select an electric renewable energy product, one hundred percent (100%) of your electricity usage will be matched with renewable energy credits (RECs), generated from qualifying renewable or alternative energy sources in the United States that include at least one of the following types of renewable generation: wind, solar, biomass, biogas, hydroelectric, off-shore wind, tidal (ocean), fuel cells, liquid biofuel, and any other generation source that qualifies as renewable in Pennsylvania. The applicable generation resource mix and environmental characteristics of the electric supply sold by Renaissance Power & Gas is available at www.renaissancepowerandgas.com.

25. **Electronic Communications with Customer.** Customer acknowledges that Renaissance Power & Gas may send communications to Customer at the Customer's email address provided by the Customer. If Customer does not consent to receive communications by email, Customer may contact Renaissance Power & Gas at the information provided above. Customer agrees and acknowledges that the information associated with the Account(s) hereunder, including but not limited to usage data, the Local Utility issued account numbers, service address and any other such information contained in this Agreement are not considered confidential or protected information. Therefore, Renaissance Power & Gas is authorized to send unencrypted email messages to Customer and/or Customer's authorized agent or representative which email may include a copy of this Agreement or other Account(s) related information necessary for Renaissance Power & Gas to perform its obligations under this Agreement.
