Response

The Comprehensive Goods and Services Agreement represents a contract by and among PPL Electric and all other affiliated interests of PPL Electric, including the 4 public utilities that are subsidiaries of PPL Corporation: Kentucky Utilities Company, a public utility organized under Virginia and Kentucky law and doing business in Virginia as Old Dominion Power Company, Louisville Gas and Electric Company, a public utility organized under Kentucky law, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, a public utility organized under Pennsylvania law and The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy, a public utility organized under Rhode Island law.

Pennsylvania and Virginia law requires pre-approval of certain affiliate interest contracts or arrangements before such contracts or arrangements are valid or effective. See 66 Pa.C.S. § 2102(a); Va. Code § 56-77(A). Rhode Island and Kentucky law does not require such pre-approval; however, Rhode Island law requires that a public utility file certain affiliate interest contracts or arrangements with the Rhode Island Division of Public Utilities and Carriers ("RI Division") within 10 days of the date of contract execution or entry into the arrangement per Rhode Island General Laws § 39-3-28.

Consequently, in addition to PPL Electric's instant filing in Pennsylvania, the proposed Comprehensive Goods and Services Agreement and CAM have been submitted for regulatory approval Virginia, but not in Kentucky or Rhode Island. The final executed agreement will be filed with the RI Division once the agreement is executed after the agreement is approved in Pennsylvania and Virginia.
