Agreement of Sale between Avondale Borough, Chester County and PECO Energy Company dated October 10, 2023 for the transfer of facilities to Avondale Borough. The Agreement was filed pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §1102(a). PECO is transferring to Avondale certain assets located within this township. The facilities include 70 street light luminaires, 58 street light brackets, 12 poles, and the existing conductors extending from the luminaires to PECO's secondary wires in the case of aerial fed luminaires at no cost. Avondale will receive electric service under PECO's Street Lighting Customer Owned Facilities rate (SL-E).
